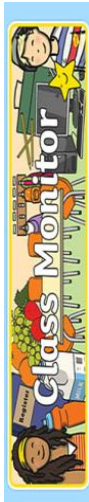


## Dear Parents

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

### 2024

It is expected that all learners come to school correctly dressed in school uniform. Boys must wear a short sleeved, open-necked shirt with a school badge on it, which is available from the school uniform shop. A tie must be worn with a long sleeve shirt. Girls must wear their green school dress. A green school jersey, blazer or the correct Dri-Mac are the only items of clothing that may be worn if the weather turns cold, by both girls and boys. **Coloured tops will be confiscated if worn.** The School Tracksuit is not school uniform and can only be worn for all sports meetings, they are available, in the office. Learners may not wear any jewellery, ONLY Gold stud or sleeper earrings may be worn as well as a Medic-Alert bracelet. Hair must be neat at all times. No child may have bleached or coloured hair. No ornate hairstyles are acceptable. Please be aware that the school **cannot be held responsible** for Cell phones that are brought to school.
