SCHOOL UNIFORM 2024

It is expected that all learners come to school correctly dressed in school uniform. In winter boys must wear a long-sleeved white shirt and long grey pants. Girls must wear a long sleeve white shirt and green school pants. **A school tie must be worn by both boys and girls in winter.** A green school jersey, blazer or the correct school jacket are the only items of clothing that may be worn if the weather turns cold, by both girls and boys. **Coloured tops will be confiscated if worn.** The School Tracksuit is not school uniform and can only be worn for all sports meetings, they are available, in the office. Learners may not wear any jewellery, ONLY Gold stud or sleeper earrings may be worn as well as a Medic-Alert bracelet. Hair must be neat at all times. No child may have bleached or coloured hair.
